EXTRACURRICULAR CODE OF CONDUCT

For 6th, 7th, and 8th graders

Students participating in extracurricular activities are representing not only themselves, but their parents, school and community. Their conduct should reflect respect for all individuals and property.

Therefore, these students will demonstrate:

- Respect for peers, teachers, staff (e.g. officials, coaches, directors), audiences and spectators and property.
- Appropriate behavior during school and all CCS extracurricular activities. Rules and expectations that govern behavior at school are expected at all these activities. Certain misconducts (e.g. physical aggression, harassment, bullying, destroying property) will result in immediate suspension from the activity.

Students will not be eligible to participate in a CCS extracurricular activity on a day during which:

- The student has been absent due to illness.
- The student has had an unexcused absence or unexcused tardy after 9:00 a.m.
- The student has been referred to the Opportunity Room and it was determined that s/he violated a school policy or rule and it is further determined that missing the extracurricular activity is an appropriate consequence.
- It has been prearranged because of a previous infraction as the day that the non-participation will be incurred.

The principal (or designee), in consult with the appropriate staff member(s), will make the determination about eligibility.
